MULTIPLE CONCENTRATIONS AND DEGREES

USF allows up to three concentrations in the BM degree. In addition to performance, the student can choose Music Composition and/or Jazz Studies. The BS degree in music education is a separate degree program. Majors in the BM and/or BS degree programs cannot enroll in the BA degree in Music Studies. Also, majors in music cannot minor in music, but they can enroll in other music courses as electives. Consult with the music advisor and the Office of Financial Aid before declaring additional concentrations, degrees, and before enrolling in extracurricular courses. Additional concentrations under the BM degree are not regarded as double majors or dual degrees and will count toward Excess Credit Hours Surcharge (ECHS).

Recital Attendance

Put name and U-number on programs and deliver them to music office, MUS 101, within one week. Register for **Recital Attendance** (MUS 2010) only in the semester in which you will complete a minimum total of 80 to receive an “S” grade (0 credit hours).

Chamber Music

Participating in chamber ensembles is highly encouraged for music elective credit.

Piano Performance Majors

Piano majors must take at least one semester of Piano Pedagogy MVK 4640 as a music elective.

Voice Performance Majors

- Must take three semesters of MUS 2201 Language Diction for Singers as music electives.
- Must demonstrate proficiency in French, German, and Italian by completing one semester of each language (1120, 1120L) or by passing the respective placement tests in the Division of World Languages, Cooper Hall – 4th Floor.
- Upper-division students may take up to two semesters of opera as a major ensemble.
- Students who elect and are allowed to take applied music beyond their minimal degree requirements will have the option of enrolling in either choral ensembles or opera.

Semester Planning

Meet with the music advisor each semester for assistance in planning courses. Remember that not all courses are offered every semester, and many courses have prerequisites.
